What is changing?

A Projects sub-ledger will be used to route most transactions before they are recorded in the general ledger.

What do I need to know?

- Become familiar with the concept of projects and how they relate to fund sources and indices
- Understand the fields required to record a project-related transaction
- Learn how to review project financial performance and report on expenditures charged to projects
- Understand how to perform project cost adjustments for transactions recorded in the Projects module
